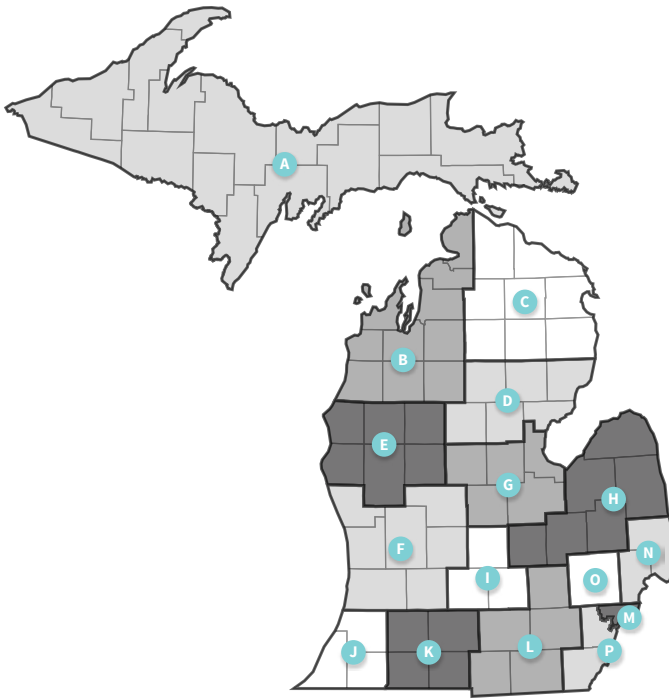

The **16 multi-faceted and diverse Michigan Works! organizations** cover the state with efficient, effective tools capable of building jobs, leveraging careers and developing core talent. Michigan Works! is building -- and leading -- strong networks that boost community, economic and talent development through a variety of activities, including:

- **GOING PRO TALENT FUND:** With over **6,000** companies and **175,000** workers benefitting from the program since 2014, the Michigan Works! network uses the Going PRO Talent Fund to ensure Michigan's employers have the talent they need to compete and grow; individuals have the skills they need for in-demand jobs; and support an increase in credentials, certificates and degrees through employer-responsive training.
- **REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIPS:** Michigan Works! is dedicated to working alongside the State of Michigan to account for the growing shortage of skilled workers across a wide spectrum of industries. Specifically, Apprenticeship Success Coordinators assist in the development of new Registered Apprenticeship Programs in high-wage, in-demand industries, and occupations. These coordinators work directly with employers and function as facilitators, problem solvers, change agents and relationship builders in support of apprenticeship programming. Their support has expanded programming the state, resulting in more than **8,969** more registered apprenticeship programs in the state since 2014. Currently there are **19,629** active apprentices working in the State of Michigan, and the local Michigan Works! agencies are crucial in the continuing growth of apprenticeship programs in Michigan.
